1. Recruitment

Recruitment shall be done for (12) number of vacancies in various categories as per the details enclosed in the Annexure-I.

2. Applications

Applications are hereby invited by the Narayanpet District Selection Committee headed by the District Collector & District Magistrate Narayanpet District from the eligible applicants to the vacant posts.

3. Age

The minimum age is 18 years and maximum ages 44 years in terms of (Rule-12 (1) (a) (v) of Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules 1996). The minimum and maximum age shall be reckoned as on 1-7-2026 with the following relaxations allowed fore locking the maximum age limit as per rules in force.

4. Qualifications:

The suitable qualifications for the vacant posts shall be as per Government guidelines, mentioned in the Annexure-I.

5. Method of Recruitment:

Recruitment shall be done by the **District Selection Committee** on behalf of the concerned District Health Society, for all the vacant positions.

The recruitment is made on contract basis and the contract is initially for a period of one year and renewal will be as per the need and NHM yearly plan(PIP) and also subject to satisfactory performance.

The District Selection Committee shall consist of the following members:

For the posts of MLHPs, the guidelines for recruitment issued by this office vide **Lr.Rc.No.96/NHM/HWC/NHM/2017, dated 06.09.2022 (Para-10)** shall be followed. For age, the guidance issued at "**3) Age**" shall be followed.

Other than MLHP positions, the following guidelines shall be followed:

6. Selection

Selection will be done on **Merit Basis** based on the following criteria:

- Merit Lists shall be prepared separately for each category of posts.
- Total marks are **100**, of which:
 - 90 marks** will be allotted based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

- **10 marks** will be awarded for age.
- Weightage for age will be reckoned from **18 years of age** of the candidate.
- **0.5 mark** will be awarded for one completed year of age, with a maximum of **10 marks**.
- Age will be reckoned as on **01.07.2026**.
- Example:
 - If a candidate completes 20 years of age as on 01.07.2026 → **1.0 mark**
 - 30 years → **6.0 marks**
 - 38 years → **10.0 marks**

Merit list will be prepared based on the marks obtained with the above criteria and displayed on the Official Website of the Narayanpet District Collector, for transparency and also for calling objections.

Selection list will be prepared from the finalized merit list duly following the **Rule of Reservation (RoR), Presidential Orders and SC-ST reservation rules**.

Selected candidates shall maintain the **Headquarters**.

These positions are **not transferable**.

7. Rule of Reservation

1. Rule of Reservations in respect of **Community, Disability, Ex-Service Men/Women** shall be strictly observed as ordered by the Government of Telangana from time to time.
2. **33⅓% reservation for women** will be applicable as per the orders issued by Government in **G.O.Ms.No.3, Dept. for Women, Children, Disabled & Sr. Citizens (Prog.I), dated 10.02.2024** and **G.O.Ms.No.35, Genl.Admin. (Ser.D) Dept., dated 13.02.2024**.
3. The Rule of Reservation to **local candidates** is applicable as per the Presidential Order and also SC-ST reservation rules.
4. The Rule of Reservation is applicable in case where more than one post is available for recruitment. Hence, in respect of a single permitted post, the recruitment shall be made strictly on the basis of merit.
5. The districts should continue the existing **Roster**.
6. Vacancies for posts mentioned in **G.O.68**, falling in Scheduled Areas, should be filled exclusively with the **Local Scheduled Tribes**.

8. How to Apply

1. Application forms along with instructions can be downloaded from the official website (www.narayanpet.telangana.gov.in) of the Narayanpet District.
2. Filled-in application forms shall be submitted **in person or through registered post** to the respective District Medical & Health Officer of the District to which the candidate is applying.
 - Applications received after the due date will be summarily rejected.
 - District Selection Committee is not responsible for postal delays.

1) In the Health Wellness Centers located in **municipal areas**, the positions will first be filled up with MBBS doctors as per eligibility. After exhausting the MBBS doctors, these vacancies will be filled with BAMS doctors as per eligibility.

2).In the Health Wellness Centers located in **Non- municipal areas**, the positions will first be filled up with MBBS doctors as per eligibility. After exhausting the MBBS doctors, these vacancies will be filled with BAMS doctors as per eligibility. If no doctors are available, then these positions can be filled up by Staff Nurses as per eligibility.

11. General Information to the Candidates

1. The District Collector reserves the right to **change/modify/cancel the selection process** at any time during the process, and the decision of the District Collector will be final and binding.
2. The mode of appointment is on **Outsourcing basis or Contract basis** for a period of **1 year or till the actual need ceases, whichever is earlier**.
3. No **TA/DA** will be paid to the candidates for attending interviews.
4. Appointees will work under the overall administrative control of **CH&FW and MD, NHM**.
5. The termination notice shall be **30 days** from either side.
6. Candidates selected under Outsourcing mode shall be appointed through the **Outsourcing Agency**.
7. The posts notified are **not permanent/regular Government posts** and are purely temporary.
8. The panel of candidates will be utilized for future vacancies, until a period of **one year from the final date of selection of candidates** in this notification.
9. Selected candidates will be intimated through **email/official communication**.
10. Selected candidates may have to perform **tours**.
11. Their performance will be evaluated from time to time and the same will be considered for **extension/termination of their service**, in case of future requirements.
12. The employment is subject to **disciplinary/codal rules** and, in case of any deviation, employment is liable for termination.
